

Trumpet Fingering Chart

This chart provides the standard fingering and valve combinations for the first four lines of a trumpet. Each note is represented by a whole note on a five-line staff, with a diagram above it showing the placement of fingers (1, 2, 3) on the valves. The notes are organized into four rows of seven notes each.
