

# 20 Minute Routine

Lip Slurs





Each note must be flowing into the next one without hesitation



**Tonguing**      Play 3 x's with "too" and 3 x's with "doo"



**Expanding Scales**      The quality of sound must remain the same as you ascend.



I am convinced that a "Daily Practice Routine of Fundamentals" is crucial to a trumpet player's development. This 20 Minute Routine is just the beginning. The secret is to DO IT every day!
